# **Checklist for Stand Construction**



Stand booked and booking confirmation received from organiser?

Invoice sent?

### Stand package booked?

<u>Please note</u>: Some of the following items are already included and do not need to be booked separately! (e.g.: Carpet, walls, electricity, stand grounding, spotlights, logo print - see Exhibitor Shop)

The stand package is mandatory for B stands.

For A and C stands, the stand package or individual tools floor covering/carpet and walls are obligatory.

#### Stand Wall (incl. stand number) booked?

• or will this be provided by a third party/your own service? (Do not forget the stand number!)

## **Carpet/ Flooring booked?**

• or will this be provided by a third party/provided by the exhibitor?

**Electricity** required?

**Stand-earthing** required? (see also exhibitor information)

LAN with optional W-Lan?

Furniture required?

**Spotlights** required? (only suitable for the type of stand offered in the shop)

### Fire Protection/ Safety Checks

<u>B1 Certification</u> according to DIN 4102 (or EU standard A2; B; C-S1, d0) for textile equipment such as banners, flags, pavilions etc. must be presented on request.

1 <u>smoke-detector</u> required per 8m<sup>2</sup> "covered area" (umbrellas, pavilions etc.)

Own <u>sprinkler-system</u> from 30m<sup>2</sup> covered area.

Fixings (e.g. fastening of tents in the outdoor area) must be made of metal. No textile straps!

<u>Metal fasteners are always required for fastening objects</u> at an elevated position (e.g. on the truss system). (Not plastic cable ties!)

Do not forget to additionally <u>secure lighting equipment</u> in an elevated position with a safety cable. Attention: Earthing always required for traverse!

<u>Securing of stairs</u> (e.g. stairs to show trailers in outdoor areas) with:

- Visual labelling on the edge of the step (red/white, yellow/white adhesive tape)
- Handrails on both sides from 3 steps upwards.

Stand/ Objects set up must be stable and must not protrude into the mandatory escape route.
